- **Increased insecurity**

In some conflicts areas, such as Iraq, Syria, Somalia and Nigeria, women and girls have also been abducted and forced to marry.



### More needs to be done to protect girls from child marriage during crises:

- Recognise child marriage as a critical issue in times of crisis not just an afterthought
- Identify what makes girls vulnerable to child marriage in 2 humanitarian crises by involving and listening to them.
- Include child marriage prevention and support to married girls in any humanitarian response from the beginning of a crisis. Involve all sectors.
- Do more research to understand how crises affect adolescent girls in different contexts
